MEMO TO: All Residents of Upper Leacock Township

On July 1, 1991, the Township began recycling as mandated by Ordinance #91-3 and amended in Ordinance #03-7. This Ordinance requires all residents to separate designated materials for recycling and requires trash collectors to be licensed and to adopt procedures to implement such recycling.

The Township is required by State law, Act 97, to provide this program, and you are required by the Township's Ordinance to participate in it. We hope, however, that you find other reasons to participate. Recycling is beneficial for both environmental and economic reasons and makes your trash more manageable between collection days. Trash collection bills probably will continue to rise because of increasing disposal costs, but you can help control the costs of refuse service by participating in the recycling program. Even better, recycling goes a long way toward conserving our natural resources, reducing pollution and making the fullest use of available landfill space. *It's the right thing to do!*
