# POLLUTANT CONTROL MEASURES FOR WATERS IMPAIRED BY PATHOGENS UPPER LEACOCK TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY, PA

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NPDES MS4 Permit PAI 133537 September 29, 2020

Impaired Waters
Conestoga River

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### **SUMMARY**

As an MS4 community with locally impaired streams, Upper Leacock Township must comply with Appendix B of the Township's Individual Permit (Attachment A1). The Township is responsible for implementing Pollutant Control Measures (PCMs) within the storm sewershed of any outfall that discharges to waters impaired due to Pathogens. In their Annual MS4 Status Report due to Pennsylvania's Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) no later than September 30, 2019, the Township submitted the required map of the storm sewersheds associated with all outfalls that discharge to surface waters subject to Appendix B.

This report contains the inventory intended to meet the requirements of Appendix B as spelled out in the Individual Permit:

# Appendix B Inventory

The permittee shall develop an inventory of all suspected and known sources of bacteria in stormwater within the storm sewershed, at a minimum, that discharge to impaired waters. The inventory must identify whether the source is suspected or known, the basis for this determination, the responsible party (if known), and any corrective action the permittee has taken or plans to take for any of these sources.

Upper Leacock Township must submit the inventory for Appendix B to PA DEP with an Annual MS4 Status report due no later than September 30, 2020.

Over the course of the 2018-2023 MS4 Permit term, Upper Leacock Township will continue to implement PCMs in accordance with Appendix B and prepare and submit updates on the progress of implementing these PCMs with the MS4 Annual Report due each year to PA DEP by September 30<sup>th</sup>.

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# **SECTION A – POLLUTANTS OF CONCERN**

As an MS4 community with locally impaired streams, Upper Leacock Township must comply with Appendix B of the Township's Individual Permit (Attachment A1). The Township is responsible for implementing Pollutant Control Measures (PCMs) within the storm sewershed of any outfall that discharges to waters impaired due to Pathogens. The pollutants of concern are based on the impairment listing provided in the MS4 Requirements Table provided by PA DEP (Attachment A2):

Conestoga River (Appendix B): Pathogens

Pathogens are the single most frequent cause of water quality impairment in the United States, with impairments usually identified based on elevated counts of fecal indicator bacteria (FIB), such as *Escherichia coli* (*E. coli*), enterococci or fecal coliform. Pathogens are disease-causing organisms, whereas FIB indicate the potential presence of such organisms. Determinations regarding impairment are based on comparison of FIB concentrations to applicable waterbody standards and classifications, and sources of pathogens and FIB in MS4s and receiving waters vary widely, originating from both animal and human sources.<sup>1</sup>

# **SECTION B – MAPS**

Upper Leacock Township has completed mapping that shows the location of the municipal boundary, impaired and non-impaired streams, watershed boundaries, parcel boundaries, and the properties that represent suspected or known sources of Pathogens in stormwater. This information is provided on the following map included in this section. Please note that some streams identified on the maps as impaired, may be impaired for reasons that do not need to be considered by the Township when implementing PCMs. This inventory addresses only those impairments that require Appendix B (see Section A for specific information on applicable impairments).

# SECTION C – DEVELOP INVENTORY FOR SOURCES OF POLLUTANTS OF CONCERN

Identifying the likely sources and associated transport pathways of Pathogen impairments is a critical component of improving water quality. Upper Leacock Township has taken the first step by delineating the drainage areas/sewersheds of all regulated outfalls discharging to impaired waters. The next step is to identify the land use and activities that occur within those drainage areas and evaluate whether the land use and/or activity could be a potential source of Pathogens.

In April 2017, Upper Leacock Township analyzed existing topographic and contour information on a GIS map to delineate the drainage area/sewershed to each regulated MS4 outfall. This was done to quantify the existing pollutant loading rates (lbs/year) for sediment, phosphorus, and nitrogen generated from within their regulated/planning area. In August 2019, the Township created a map showing the storm sewersheds associated with all outfalls that discharge to surface waters subject to Appendix B. The Township submitted this map with their Annual MS4 Status Report due to Pennsylvania's Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) no later than September 30, 2019.

For the purposes of this Inventory Report, the Township reviewed land uses and activities that could be a potential source of Pathogens in stormwater.

<u>Appendix B</u> – Table 3-1. Potential Sources of fecal indicator bacteria (FIB) in Urbanized Areas and Adjoining Watersheds<sup>2</sup> (see Attachment C1)

The Township utilized Geographic Information System (GIS) spatial data of Lancaster County parcels (properties) to evaluate land uses located either partially or completely within the regulated storm sewersheds. The GIS Division of the Lancaster County Information Technology Department is responsible for acquiring, maintaining, and distributing spatial data for Lancaster County. Parcel data is available and regularly updated as an online Feature Service, which was used to develop an inventory for sources of Pathogens. A land use code is assigned to each parcel record in the dataset with descriptions of all individual land uses provided on the Lancaster County Land Use Code Sheet updated January 5, 2017 (see Attachment C2).

To begin an inventory of suspected sources of Pathogens in stormwater, Upper Leacock Township performed the following tasks:

- 1. Add Lancaster County parcel data and Upper Leacock Township storm sewershed data to ArcMap, the main component of Esri's ArcGIS suite of geospatial processing programs.
- 2. Use the Spatial Join operation to join attributes from one feature to another based on spatial relationship with the parcels as the Target Features and the storm sewersheds as the Join Features.
- 3. Customize the output settings in order to include parcels having any intersection with a regulated storm sewershed.

- 4. Review the output and manually check for accuracy.
- 5. Use land use coding to designate a parcel as a suspected source of Pathogens in stormwater.
- 6. For each parcel, verify that the land use coding is consistent with the existing land use.

To generate the Appendix B Inventory for Upper Leacock Township, parcels with the following land use classifications were identified:

- 113 One Family Dwelling (Upper Leacock Township Municipal Authority Pumping Stations)
- 486 Sewage Disposal
- 523 Restaurants Typically Providing Full-Course Meals & Alcoholic Beverages
- 525 Snack Bars, Drive-ins, Ice Cream Bars Usually Seasonal Operations with Window and/or Car Service or Limited to Counter Service
- 527 Bars, Typically Those which Provide only Alcoholic Beverages
- 766 City/Borough/Township-owned Public Parks and Recreation Areas
- 801 Vacant Land Agricultural Activities
- 810 Field Crops, Truck Crops, and Fruit Crops
- 823 Poultry and Poultry Products
- 824 Beef, Cattle, Calves, Hogs, Sheep, Dairy Products

For Appendix B, the Township must identify whether the potential source is suspected or known, the basis for this determination, the responsible party (if known), and any corrective action the permittee has taken or plans to take for any of these sources.

All parcels identified via land use coding have been classified as suspected sources of pathogens. Upper Leacock Township will complete an investigation of each suspected source and submit the results of the investigation with an Annual MS4 Status report due no later than September 30, 2022.

# **Inventory Glossary**

ID – Assigned to correspond with labeling on Attachment B1.

ACCOUNT – The 13-digit number assigned to each parcel, or groups of parcels, for tax purposes by the Lancaster County Property Assessment Office.

LANDUSECD – The 3-digit land use code assigned to each parcel, or groups of parcels, by the Lancaster County Property Assessment Office.

LU\_DESC – The description of each 3-digit land use code assigned to each parcel, or groups of parcels, by the Lancaster County Property Assessment Office.

ADDRESS – The address number (if provided) and road name of the parcel.

OWNER\_NAME – The current owner of record for the parcel.

OWNER\_ADD – The address number (if provided), road name, and City, State, and Zip Code for the current owner of record.

SEWERSHED – The designated drainage area/sewershed to each regulated MS4 outfall, as identified by Upper Leacock Township.

SUSP\_KNOWN – Identification of whether the source of impairment is suspected or known.

RESP\_PARTY — Either the OWNER\_NAME, successor entity, or the name of the business operating on the property.

COR\_ACTION – Corrective actions the Township has taken or plans to take.

### APPENDIX B

# POLLUTANT CONTROL MEASURES FOR WATERS IMPAIRED BY PATHOGENS

The permittee shall implement the following Pollutant Control Measures (PCMs) within the storm sewershed of any outfall that discharges to waters impaired due to Pathogens (e.g., Fecal Coliform), regardless of whether there is an approved TMDL:

# A. Map and Inventory.

- 1. The permittee shall develop map(s) of the storm sewershed(s) associated with all outfalls that discharge to surface waters subject to Appendix B. The purpose is to identify the area the permittee is responsible for within its legal boundaries in developing a source inventory. The map(s) shall be submitted to DEP with an Annual MS4 Status Report that is due no later than **September 30, 2019**.
- 2. The permittee shall develop an inventory of all suspected and known sources of bacteria in stormwater within the storm sewershed, at a minimum, that discharge to impaired waters. The inventory must identify whether the source is suspected or known, the basis for this determination, the responsible party (if known), and any corrective action the permittee has taken or plans to take for any of these sources. The inventory shall be submitted to DEP with an Annual MS4 Status Report is due no later than September 30, 2020.
- B. The permittee shall complete an investigation of each suspected source. This investigation must include stormwater sampling if the investigation is required as part of implementing the IDD&E program under MCM #3 of the permit, and otherwise is voluntary. The results of the investigation shall be submitted to DEP with an Annual MS4 Status Report that is due no later than September 30, 2022.
- C. The permittee shall enforce ordinances that prohibit illicit and illegal connections and discharges of sewage to the MS4. Anytime an illicit and illegal connection or discharge of sewage into the MS4 is discovered by the permittee, the permittee shall report the finding in the subsequent Annual MS4 Status Report along with a description of corrective action by the permittee.
- D. If not already established in its Stormwater Management Ordinance (municipal permittees) or SOP (non-municipal permittees), the permittee shall enact an ordinance or develop and adopt an SOP that requires proper management of animal wastes on property owned by the permittee. If an ordinance or SOP already exists that controls animal wastes, it must be attached to the first Annual MS4 Status Report due no later than September 30, 2019. If a new ordinance or SOP is enacted or adopted, the new ordinance or SOP must be attached to the first Annual MS4 Status Report due no later than September 30, 2022.
- E. The permittee shall document the progress of its investigations, source control efforts and BMPs to control sources of pathogens in its Annual MS4 Status Reports.

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
